Thomas M. Palmerlee is the Associate Director of Technical Activities Division at the Transportation Research Board (TRB). Mr. Palmerlee staffs committees on information technology and transportation data, including the Geographic Information Science and Applications Committee and the Geospatial Data Acquisition Technologies in Design and Construction Committee, as well as Transportation Asset Management. Conferences and workshops currently being planned include *Adapting Freight Models and Traditional Freight Data Programs for Performance Measurement Workshop* for the FHWA Freight Office, *Transit GIS*, the *10th National Conference on Transportation Asset Management* and *NATMEC: Improving Traffic Data Collection, Analysis, and Use*. Prior to joining TRB, Mr. Palmerlee was the executive director for the University Consortium for Geographic Information Science (UCGIS), and for the Urban and Regional Information Systems Association (URISA). In the 1980's he served as a legislative assistant and legislative director for U.S. Senator Malcolm Wallop of Wyoming.
